

1- DETERMINE: WHAT ARE YOU HUNGRY FOR?

- *Hungry to be hungry for God. (Wanting your desire for God to grow.)
- *Hungry to address other "hungers." (Desires, distractions, habits)

*Hungry to hear from God. (Direction, clarity, wisdom)

- *Hungry for God's presence. (To experience Him and closeness with Him.)
- *Hungry for God to answer prayer. (What is your request? Who is it for?)

2- CHOOSE A FASTING VERSE

*A verse about fasting.

*A verse about hunger/thirst.

*A verse that's been speaking to you, or sticking with you.

*A verse that addresses what's on your heart and mind.

3- HOW WILL YOU FAST? (FOOD FAST)

*Determine that fasting from food is safe and wise for you at this time.

*Fast over a mealtime.

*Fast for a day.

*Fast from types of food/drinks.

*Do an extended fast. (More than 1 day)

*Will it be a recurring fast? (Daily? Weekly? Duration?)

*Make a plan for how you will use the time you would have been eating.

4- BEYOND FASTING FROM FOOD

*Media (TV, radio, YouTube, gaming)

*Social Media

*Technology (smartphones, tablets, apps)

*Is there something you can/should experiment in cutting back on?

How will you fast?

*Block of time each day? Fast for a day? An extended fast? Other?

*Recurring? (Daily? Weekly?)

*Duration?

*How will you use the time you would have been doing that activity?

5- WRITE THINGS DOWN

*Write out a prayer or (prayers) telling God what you are hungry for.

*Write down your fasting verse and keep it visible.

- *Write down thoughts, feelings and challenges in the process.
 *Write down what you are learning/discovering in the process.
- *Write down anything you think God is saying to you in the process.

Verses for fasting

"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

Matthew 5:6

"When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show others they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full. But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, 1so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you."

Matthew 6:16-18

He said to them, "Because of your little faith. For truly, I say to you, if you have faith like a grain of mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move, and nothing will be impossible for you. But this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting."
