Faith and Character

Has a vibrant and dynamic relationship with God and the church. Models character qualities of Christian leadership (1 Timothy 3:1-13), aligns and adheres with the EFCC Statement of Faith and Ethos, and commits to FLCC's mission and lifestyle expectations. Has a clear sense of ministry call to glorify God, serve the church and impact the world by facilitating *spirit and truth* worship experiences (John 4:23-24)

Leadership Qualities

Seeks God (ministry is an outflow of love for God and a desire to be led by the Holy Spirit), Seeks Growth (a heart to increasingly become closer to Jesus and to be more like him), Seeks Good for others (through service and the gospel), Gospel-centred (points others- inside and outside the church- to Jesus and his gospel,) Relational (sincerely invests in others' growth and well-being), Musical skill/gifting (has both vocal/musical ability to confidently lead and equip others), Solid theological foundation (committed to biblically true understandings of God), Student of Culture (values cultural relevance and creativity in worship), Organized (has administrative ability to do things well), Learner (committed to their own ongoing growth), Networker (engages with worship people/resources outside our context for growth and development.)

Role and Responsibilities

- Develop worship ministry vision and ministry culture that reflects FLCC's Culture Statement
- Lead worship as a part of a rotation or worship teams
- Identify and recruit worship, tech and media team members
- Provide training, ongoing development, and teambuilding for worship team members.
- Share and defer leadership to equipping and empowering other worship leaders/teams
- Take the lead in planning Sunday and Seasonal worship gatherings:
 - Sundays: worship set, announcements, prayer, testimonies, coordinating with preacher
 - Examples of seasonal: Good Friday, Christmas Eve, congregational meetings, special events
- Oversee worship ministry scheduling and communication. (Calendar, practices, teams)
- · Oversee tech aspects of worship services, such as audio, media and online streaming
- · Provide direction and collaboration with arts, media, social media, and communication
